

## **305 POLICY IMPLEMENTATION**

### **I. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to clarify the responsibility of the Carver-Scott Educational Cooperative administration for implementation of governing board policy.

### **II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY**

- A. It shall be the responsibility of the executive director to implement governing board policy and to recommend additions or modifications thereto. The administration is authorized to develop guidelines and directives to effectuate the implementation of governing board policies. These guidelines and directives shall not be inconsistent with said policies. At least annually, these written procedures shall be presented to the governing board for review.
- B. Employee and student handbooks shall be subject to annual review and approval by the governing board.
- C. Administrators who have handbook responsibilities shall present recommended changes necessary to reflect new or modified policies. Changes of substance within handbooks shall be reviewed by the executive director to assure compliance with governing board policy and shall be approved by the governing board.
